Personal History

Frank SLATER was born at Bolton, Lancashire in 1881 the son of John SLATER.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 11, Cross Street, Blackpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 30 with the occupation of Railway Goods Checker.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Anne SLATER (nee HAMER) They married at Holy Trinity, South Shore, Blackpool on 30 September 1908. They had children: Sybil b.1911, John b. 1913, Annie b. 1914

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. as a Checker

He was living at Blackpool, Lancashire when he enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at the same place.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 19 December 1916 aged 35

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
