John SLATER was born at Rishton, Lancashire in 1892 the son of John Thomas and Elizabeth Ann SLATER nee MCCALISTER who were married 15/05/1880 at St. Peter & St. Paul, Rishton, Lancashire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 5, Clifton Street, Rishton, Lancashire,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Railway Porter.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 14. Burton Street, Rishton, Lancashire.,. He was aged 8 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Accrington as a Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the Royal Field Artillery at Blackburn, Lancashire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 7 April 1918 aged 24

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
