Personal History

John Joseph SMITH was born at Manchester, Lancashire in 1879 the son of John and Lily SMITH.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Ellen SMITH (maiden name not known)

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Labourer

Service History

He was living at Kirkham, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Lytham, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 4 May 1915. His last known address was Preston, Lancashire, Catherine Street, 16 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 15 June 1915 aged 36

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
