*George SOLAN was born at Manchester, Lancashire in 1898 the son of Thomas and Julia SOLAN nee LANAGAN who were married 1892 at Manchester Register Office or Registrar Attended . His mother died in 1940.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 85, Osborne Street Rochdale Road, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 12*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 23, Pilling Street, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 2  
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Assistant Timekeeper*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire.*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 4 October 1917 aged 19*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal*
