George SOLAN was born at Manchester, Lancashshire in 1898 the son of Thomas and Julia SOLAN nee LANAGAN who were married 1892 at Manchester Register Office or Registrar Attended. His mother died in 1940.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 85, Osborne Street Rochdale Road, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 12

In the 1901 census the family were living at 23, Pilling Street, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 2 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Assistant Timekeeper

He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 4 October 1917 aged 19 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
