Personal History

He was a married man. His wife's name was Ruth Annie STANSFIELD (maiden name not known)

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Bradford as a Washer

Service History

He enlisted in the West Yorkshire Regiment. and embarked for France on 16 April 1915.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 22 July 1916

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
