Personal History

Harry BESWICK was born at Bury, Lancashire in 1895 the son of John and Louisa BESWICK nee MCCANN who were married 04/12/1880 at St. Peter, Bury, Lancashire. His father died in 1936. His mother died in 1936.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 3, Parliament Place, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Croft Boy at Bleachworks.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 25, Central Avenue, Radcliffe, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 5 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Bury as a Cleaner

Service History

He enlisted in the Grenadier Guards at Bury, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 26 July 1915. His last known address was Bury, Parliament Place, 3 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 16 October 1915 aged 21

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
