Personal History

Edwin Arthur STOKES was born at Horwich, Lancashire in 1892 the son of Charles and Fanny STOKES nee MORRIS. His mother died in 1908.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 9, Dickenson Street, West Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 9 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich

Service History

He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Bolton, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 14 March 1917 aged 25

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
