Personal History

William BIBBY was born at Bolton, Lancashire in 1891 the son of John and Harriet BIBBY. His mother died in 1903.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 4, Sadler Street, Great Lever, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 20 with the occupation of Cotton Big Piecer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 41, Grant Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 10

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as an Oiler

Service History

He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment. and embarked for France on 31 July 1915. His last known address was Bolton, Great Lever, Sadler Street, 4 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Died at home on 28 March 1918 aged 27

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
