Personal History

Robert SULLIVAN was born at Liverpool, Lancashire in 1886 the son of Robert and Mary SULLIVAN nee REGAN who were married 1880 at Liverpool Register Office or Registrar Attended . His mother died in 1946. In the 1911 census the family were living at Napier Barracks, Lahore Cant. South Lancashire Regt.. He was aged 26 with the occupation of Private.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 6, Epsom Street, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Shop Boy.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 84, Blwnheim Street, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 5 with the occupation of Scholar.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Susannah SULLIVAN (nee JONES) They married at St. Silas, Toxteth Park, Liverpool, Lancashire on 26 March 1905

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Liverpool (North Docks) as a Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the South Lancashire Regiment at Liverpool, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 14 August 1914. His last known address was Lahore Cant. Napier Barracks, South Lancashire Regiment (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 14 January 1917 in Mesopotamia aged 30

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 14 Star
