Personal History

William TALBOT was born at Orrell, Lancashire in 1880 the son of John and Ann TALBOT nee LIPTROT who were married 10/06/1876 at St. Thomas The Martyr, Uppholland, Lancashire. His father died on . In the 1911 census the family were living at 141, Woodhouse Lane Wigan, Lancashire,. He was aged 30 with the occupation of Coal Miner Hewer.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 172, Woodhouse Lane, Wigan, Lancashire,. He was aged 17? with the occupation of Iron Puddler.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Wigan as a Coalman

Service History

He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Wigan, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 6 May 1915. His last known address was Wigan, Lancashire, Woodhouse Lane, 10 (Brother) CWGC

He is recorded as Killed in action on 4 June 1915 aged 34

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
