## Personal History

John Thomas TARRANT was born at Southwark, Surrey in 1887 the son of John Thomas and Eliza Sarah TARRANT nee KIMBERLEY who were married 17/04/1881 at Holy Trinity, Newington, England. His father died in 1913. His mother died in 1913.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 26, Canada Street, All Saints, Newcastlwe on Tyne,. He was aged 13

In the 1891 census the family were living at 8, Adams Place, Southwark, London,. He was aged 4 with the occupation of A Scholar.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Emily TARRANT (nee OASTLER) They married at Preston Register Office or Registrar Attended on 25 March 1905

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Preston as an Extra Porter

## Service History

He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at London. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 12 August 1914. His last known address was Preston, Lancashire, Westmorland Street, 1 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 16 January 1917 aged 30

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
