***Personal History***

*Harry TATLOW was born at Horwich, Bolton, Lancashire in 1892 the son of James Teare and Martha TATLOW nee HUGHES who were married 1872 at Wolverhampton. His father died in 1942. His mother died in 1942.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 49, Victoria Road, Horwich, Lancashire. He was aged 19 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 49, Victoria Road, Horwich, Lancashire. He was aged 9*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Head Office as a Clerk*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 5 May 1915. His last known address was Horwich, Lancashire, Victoria Road, 49 (1911 Census).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 5 June 1915 aged 23*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
