Personal History

James TATTERSALL was born at Longton, Lancashire in 1893 the son of John and Mary TATTERSALL nee BLUNDELL who were married 20/03/1882 at St. Paul, Farrington, Lancashire. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 8, Garfield Terrace, Lostock Hall, Preston, Lancashire,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Railway Eng. Cleaner.

In the 1901 census the family were living at White House, Nook Farm, Farrington, Lancashire,. He was aged 7 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Lostock Hall as a Cleaner

Service History

He was living at Farrington, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Preston, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 25 September 1915. His last known address was Lostock Hall, Preston, Lancashire, Harold Terrace, 8 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 10 July 1916 aged 23

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
