Personal History

James Charles BILSBOROUGH was born at Ashton-on-Ribble, Preston, Lancashire in 1894 the son of Edwin Christopher and Jane Elizabeth BILSBOROUGH nee NEWSHAM who were married 1895 at St. Andrew, Ashton-on-Roibble, Preston. His father died in 1947. His mother died in 1947.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 58, Addison Road, Fleetwood, Lancashire,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Larches, Ashton-on-Ribble, Preston, Lancashire,. He was aged 7 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Wyre Dock as an Extra Checker

Service History

He was living at Fleetwood, Lancashire when he enlisted in the King's Own Royal Lancaster at the same place. on 9 September 1914

He is recorded as Killed in action on 15 August 1916 aged 21

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
