In the 1901 census the family were living at 43, Victoria Street, Farnworth, Lancashire,. He was aged 4 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

He enlisted in the Royal Navy.

He is recorded as Died on 9 July 1917 in Internal Explosion of Vessel aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & Star
