Hiram TAYLOR was born at Bury, Lancashire in 1880 the son of Jonas and Jane TAYLOR nee SUTHERHURST OR SUDREN who were married 1870 at Bury Register Office or Registrar Attended . His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 27, Samuel Street, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 31 with the occupation of Boiler Maker.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 12, Bridge Street, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 21 with the occupation of Steam Boiler Maker.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 19, St. Pauls Street, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 11 with the occupation of Scholar.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Riveter

He was living at Bury, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Army Service Corps at the same place.

He is recorded as Died on 4 March 1916 aged 36

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
