He was a married man. His wife's name was Jessie (Fiancee) TAYLOR (nee CLARK)

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at North Docks as a Porter

He enlisted in the Grenadier Guards at Liverpool, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 16 March 1915.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 9 October 1917

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
