***Personal History***

*Vernon Ashworth TAYLOR was born at Rochdale, Lancashire in 1897 the son of John and Mary TAYLOR nee HAZELTINE who were married 1895 at St. Peter, Newbold, Rochdale, Lancashire.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 1, Knowsley Grove, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Railway Office Boy.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 12, Carwood Grove, Horwich,. He was aged 4*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as an Apprentice*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Horwich, Lancashire.*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 26 October 1917 aged 20*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & Territorial Force War Medal*
