Personal History

Thomas Edgar TEECE was born at Hoyland, Yorkshire in 1890 the son of John and Mary Alice TEECE nee GREATOREX who were married 1887 at Chorlton on Medlock Register Off. or Registrar Attd. . His father died in 1937. His mother died in 1937.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 18. Lockwood Street, Drifffield, East Yorkshire,. He was aged 20 with the occupation of Shipping Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 2, Britannia Road, Barfield Terrace, Morley, Dewsbury, Yorkshire,. He was aged 10

In the 1891 census the family were living at King Street, Nether Hoyland, Barnsley, Yorkshire,. He was aged 0 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Groove Steam Shipping at Hull as a Clerk

Service History

He was living at Belper, Derbyshire when he enlisted in the East Yorkshire Regiment at Hull, Yorkshire. on 08/09?1914 and embarked for Egypt on 23 December 1915. His last known address was Drifffield, Yorkshire. Lockwood Street, 18 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 3 July 1917 aged 27

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
