Personal History

Alfred TETLEY was born at Bradford, Yorkshire in 1884 the son of George and Clara TETLEY nee CHILD. His mother died in 1939.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 186, Wakefoeld Road, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 27 with the occupation of Grease Extracter.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Aldershot, Military, Private 2nd Dragoon Guards,. He was aged 18

In the 1891 census the family were living at 120, Caladonia Street, Bowling, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 7

He was a married man. His wife's name was Emma TETLEY (maiden name not known)

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Bradford as a Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the West Riding Regiment at Bradford, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 15 July 1915. His last known address was Bradford, Yorkshire, Wakefield Road, 186 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 25 August 1918 aged 34

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
