## Personal History

Harry Blore TETLEY was born at Bradford, Yorkshire on 6 May 1892 the son of George and Clara TETLEY nee CHILD. His mother died in 1939.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 30, St. James Square, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 18 with the occupation of Railway Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 13, Sloan Street, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 8 with the occupation of Scolar.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Madeline TETLEY (nee TEALE) They married at Bradford, Yorkshire on 28 March 1905

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. as a Loader

## Service History

He enlisted in the West Riding Regiment at Bradford, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 15 July 1915. His last known address was Bradford, Yorkshire, 30, St. James Square, 30 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 24 February 1916 in 3rd Canadian Gen. Hosp. Boulogne aged 23 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
