Personal History

George Henry THIRKILL was born at Bramley, Leeds, Yorkshire on 15 April 1895 the son of George Edward and Susannah Mary H.M. THIRKILL nee KIRKBRIDE who were married 27/01/1891 at St. Peter. Leeds, Yorkshire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 2, Goodwin Street, Bramley, Leeds, Yorkshire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Worsted Mill Hand.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 24, Brunel Street, Wortley, Leeds, Yorkshire,. He was aged 5 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company

Service History

He enlisted in the West Yorkshire Regiment at Leeds, Yorkshire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 8 September 1914. His last known address was Bramley, Leeds, Yorkshire, Goodwin Street, 2 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 28 March 1918 aged 23

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 14 Star
