Personal History

Arthur THOMPSON was born at Goole, Yorkshire in 1879 the son of John Henry and Annie Elizabeth THOMPSON nee CROUDSON who were married 29/03/1873 at Goole, Yorkshire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 6, Spring Gardens, Hook Road, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 32 with the occupation of Marine Engineer, Railway.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 21, Sotheran Street, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 12 with the occupation of Scholar.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Olive THOMPSON (nee ROCKETT) They married at Goole, Yorkshire on 19 March 1905. They had children: Olive Grace b. 1906, Dick b. 1910

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company

He enlisted in the Mercantile Marine.

He is recorded as Died on 2 May 1918 aged 39
