Personal History

Major THORPE was born at Birmingham, Wqarwickshire in 1892 the son of Sedley Tanjore and Emma THORPE nee BETTS who were married 1886 at Aston, Birmingham, Warwickshire. His father died on . In the 1911 census the family were living at 58, Smedley Lane, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 19 with the occupation of Restaurant Kitchen Porter.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 25, Howell Street, Broughton, Salford, Lancashire,. He was aged 9 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company at Newton Heath as a Driller

Service History

He was living at Harpurhey, Manchester when he enlisted in the Royal Garrison Artillery at Manchester, Lancashire. on 13 November 1915

He is recorded as Died on 22 September 1919 in Bronchial Pneumonia aged 27

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
