Personal History

Frederick THREADGOLD was born at Stainley, Ripon, Yorkshire in 1899 the son of George and Emily Jane THREADGOLD nee SABAN who were married 1896 at Pocklington, Yorkshire. His father died in 1955. His mother died in 1955.

In the 1911 census the family were living at Burgh Mill, Dewsbury, Yorkshire,. He was aged 12 In the 1901 census the family were living at Vill. He was aged with the occupation of South Stailey, Ripon, Yorkshire, Age 2.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Cleaner

He was living at Mirfield, Yorkshire when he enlisted in the East Yorkshire Regiment at Dewsbury, Yorkshire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 4 October 1917 aged 18 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
