

Private Richard TICKLE

11841 6th Battalion Loyal North Lancashire Regiment Died of Wounds 27 August 1915 aged 20

Personal History

Richard TICKLE was born at Bolton, Lancashire in 1895 the son of Richard and Sarah Ellen TICKLE nee DERBYSHIRE who were married 1888 at St. Mary the Virgin, Deane Parish Church, Bolton. His father died in 1920. His mother died in 1920.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 23, Barlow Street, Horwich, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Labourer Brick & Tile Works.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Labourer

Service History

He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Horwich, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 15.06/1915. His last known address was Horwich, Bolton, Lancashire, Barlow Street, 23 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 27 August 1915 in Netley Hospital aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
