## Personal History

William Thomas TOWERS was born at Blackburn, Lancashire in 1893 the son of Thomas and Jane Alice TOWERS nee RATCLIFFE who were married 02/06/1892 at Christ Church, Blackburn, Lancashire. His father died in 1943. His mother died in 1943.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 58, Taylor Street, Blackburn, Lancashire,. He was aged 18 with the occupation of Cotton Mill Weaver.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Emily TOWERS (nee CHADWICK) They married at St. Matthew, Blackburn, Lancashire on 2 January 1915. They had children: William Thomas Chadwick Towes b. 1917 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Lampman
