## Personal History

Patrick TRAYNOR was born at Hebden Bridge, Yorkshire in 1897 the son of Michael and Annie TRAYNOR nee O'DONNELL who were married 1890 at Halifax, Yorkshire. His father died in 1911. His mother died in 1911.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 8, Duke Street, Luddenden Foot, Yorkshire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Worsted Doffer Spinner.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 34, Sharratt Street, Salford, Lancashire,. He was aged 3
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers
Dept. at Hebden Bridge as a Capstan Youth

## Service History

He enlisted in the West Riding Regiment at Hebden Bridge, Yorkshire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 3 September 1916 aged 19 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
