Personal History

Herbert TUNNUCLIFFE was born at Longnor, Staffordshire on 14 September 1878 the son of William and Mary Ann TUNNUCLIFFE nee WHEELDON. His father died in 1892. His mother died in 1892.

In the 1911 census the family were living at Young's Cott. He was aged 32 with the occupation of North Dock, Dublin, Ireland, Age 32, General Labourer.

In the 1891 census the family were living at Dog Lane, Longnor, Staffordshire,. He was aged 12 with the occupation of Scholar.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Mary TUNNUCLIFFE (nee O'BRIAN) They married at St. Mary, Dublin on 31.02/1902. They had children: Annie b.1904, Herbert Bernard B.1906, Mary Anne b. 1908, Christina, b. 1910, Evelyn b. 1913

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Marsh Lane as a Porter

Service History

He was living at Dublin, Ireland when he enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Ashton Under Lyne, Lancashire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 27 October 1914. His last known address was Dublin, North Stand, Spencer Street, Spencer Place, 3 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 23 April 1915 aged 35

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 14 Star
