Personal History

James WALDRON was born at Ballyhaunis, Co. Mayo, Ireland in 1878 the son of Patrick and Mary WALDRON.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 6, Sarah Street, Rochdale, Lancashire,. He was aged 33 with the occupation of Railway Labourer.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Rochdale as a Relief Porter

He enlisted in the Royal Engineers. and embarked for France on 8 December 1914. His last known address was Thorrington, Essex, Mill Cottage

He is recorded as Died at home aged 38

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
