Personal History

Jonathan Winder WALLING was born at Silverdale, Barrow-in-Furness on 31 July 1887 the son of Daniel Robinson and Sarah WALLING nee WINDER who were married 1873 at Ulverston. His father died in 1937. His mother died in 1937.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 12, Barlow Street, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 23 with the occupation of Carter Corn Manufacturer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 26, Canon Street, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 13

In the 1891 census the family were living at 35, St. Annes Street, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 3

He was a married man. His wife's name was Rosetta Alice WALLING (nee GROVES) They married at Bury Register Office or Registrar Attended on 20 March 1905. They had children: John b.1906, Daniel Robinson b.1908, Annie b. 1909, Mary Florence b.1910, Lilian b. 1911, Agnes Gladys b. 1913, Edith May b. 1914, Rosetta Alice b. 1916

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Bury as a Point Cleaner

He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Bury, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Died on 19 December 1916 in Prisoner of War aged 29

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
