Robert WALMSLEY was born at Skelmersdale, Lancashire in 1893 the son of Joseph and Eliza Ann WALMSLEY nee RIMMER who were married 1886 at Wigan Register Office or Registrar Attended. His father died in 1938. His mother died in 1938.

In the 1911 census the family were living at Hoscar Moss, Near Ormskirk, Lancashire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Hoscar Moss Lane, Lathom. Lancashire,. He was aged 7 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

He was living at Turton, Lancashire when he enlisted in the East Lancashire Regiment at Blackburn, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 28 September 1918 aged 24 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & Military Medal
