Benjamin WALSH was born at Horwich, Lancashire in 1894 the son of Fred and Rachael WALSH nee ROSTRON who were married 1892 at Holy Trinity Church, Horwich, Lancashire. His mother died in 1936. In the 1911 census the family were living at 15, Duncan Street, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Croft Hand.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 8, George Street, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 7
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at
Horwich as a Labourer
