Personal History

David Leek WALTON was born at Hull, Yorkshire in 1897 the son of John Leek and Mildred WALTON nee PEARSON who were married 1885 at St. Stephens, Hull, Yorkshire. His father died in 1933. His mother died in 1933.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 5, Ellen Holme, Ludden Foot, Halifax, Yorkshire,. He was aged 13 with the occupation of Spinning Doffer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 9, Derwent Avenue, Sculcoates, Hull, Yorkshire,. He was aged 3 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Luddenfoot as a Teleohone Youth

He was living at Selby, Yorkshire when he enlisted in the West Riding Regiment at Halifax, Yorkshire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 27 November 1917 aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
