## Personal History

James Arthur WALTON was born at Hexthorpe, Yorkshire in 1888 the son of Arthur and Eliza WALTON. In the 1901 census the family were living at South Villas, 6, Factory Avenur? Hexthorpe, Donacaster, Yorkshire, He was aged 12

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Wagon Maker

## Service History

He enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at Doncaster, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 24 July 1915. His last known address was Hexthorpe, Doncaster, Factory Avenue? 6, South Villas (1901 Census).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 3 March 1916 aged 28

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
