Personal History

George WARING was born at Bury, Lancashire in 1894 the son of George and Elizabeth WARING nee O'HARE who were married 15/12/1888 at St Thomas, Bury, Lancashire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 96, Alfred Street, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Railway Engine Cleaner.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 89, Devon Street, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 7
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Bury as a Cleaner

Service History

He enlisted in the Royal Irish Rifles at Bury. Lancashire. and embarked for France on 21 December 1915. His last known address was Anfield, Liverpool. Venmore Street, 129 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 8 September 1916 aged 22

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
