***Personal History***

*George Ernerst WARNER was born at Barrow on Humber, Lincolnshire in 1890 the son of Oliver and Emma WARNER.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at Mabs Cott. He was aged with the occupation of Currier Lane, Ashton Under Lyne, Lancashire, Age 20, App. Joiner.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at Hall Court, Ashton Under Lyne, Lancashire,. He was aged 10*

*In the 1891 census the family were living at Humber Bank, Barrow on Humber, Lincolnshire.. He was aged 7 months*

*He was a married man. His wife's name was Nellie WARNER (nee RODGERS) They married at St. Marks, Dukinfield, Cheshire on 28 March 1905. They had children: Marjorie b. 1915*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Newton Heath Shops as a Joiner*

*He enlisted in the Royal Engineers.*

*He is recorded as Died on 28 November 1918 aged 28*
