Personal History

George Ernerst WARNER was born at Barrow on Humber, Lincolnshire in 1890 the son of Oliver and Emma WARNER.

In the 1911 census the family were living at Mabs Cott. He was aged with the occupation of Currier Lane, Ashton Under Lyne, Lancashahire, Age 20, App. Joiner.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Hall Court, Ashton Under Lyne, Lancashire,. He was aged 10 In the 1891 census the family were living at Humber Bank, Barrow on Humber, Licolnshire.. He was aged 7 months

He was a married man. His wife's name was Nellie WARNER (nee RODGERS) They married at St. Marks, Dukinfield, Cheshire on 28 March 1905. They had children: Marjorie b. 1915

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Newton Heath Shops as a Joiner

He enlisted in the Royal Engineers.

He is recorded as Died on 28 November 1918 aged 28
