Personal History

Thomas WEEDON was born at Garston, Lancashire in 1892 the son of Thomas and Margaret WEEDON nee KYLE who were married 12/02/1888 at St., Cleopas, Toxteth, Liverpool, Lncashire. His father died on.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 12. Aughton Street, Fleetwood, Lancashire,. He was aged 19 with the occupation of Railway Worker (not Legible).

In the 1901 census the family were living at 8, Wellington Grove, Bootle, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 9

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Wyre Dock as a Shunter

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Own Royal Lancaster Regiment at Fleetwood. Lancashire. and embarked for France on 14 February 1915. His last known address was Fleetwood, Lancashire, Aughton Street, 12 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 15 May 1915 aged 23

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
