Personal History

John WEMYSS was born at Harpurhey, Manchester, Lancashire in 1897 the son of James and Agnes WEMYSS nee FAUX who were married 01/01/1896 at Albert Memotial Church, Miles Platting, Manch.. In the 1911 census the family were living at 37, Brampton Street, Newton Heath, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Errand Boy.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 19, Alder Street, Collyhurst, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 5

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Newton Heath as a Cleaner

Service History

He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 1 March 1915. His last known address was Newton Heath, Manchester, Brampton Street, 37 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 20 April 1915 aged 18

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
