William Edmund WEST was born at Darwen, Lancashire in 1898 the son of Christopher and Rachel WEST nee MARSDEN who were married 1884 at Blackburn Register Office or Registrar Attended. His father died in 1914. His mother died in 1914.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 49, Harwood Street, Darwen, Lancashire,. He was aged 12 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 14. Barn Street, Darwen, Lancashire,. He was aged 2 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

He enlisted in the East Surrey Regiment at Blackburn, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 16 October 1918 aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
