Personal History

Robert WHALLEY was born at Accrington, Lancashire in 1895 the son of James and Mary WHALLEY. His father died in 1918. His mother died in 1918.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Blackpool as an Extra Porter

He enlisted in the King' Own Royal Lancaster Regiment at Blackpool, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 26 September 1917 aged 22

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
