Joseph Inman WHITE was born on 25 November 1897 the son of Joseph and Emmeline WHITE nee GREEN who were married 16/05/1891 at St. Stephen, Burmantofts, Yorkshire. His father died in 1934. His mother died in 1934.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 45, Greyhound Place, York Road, Leeds, Yorkshire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Brick Works Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 23, Woodmag Terrace, Leeds, Yorkshire,. He was aged 5
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers
