Personal History

William WIGGLESWORTH was born at Wakefield, Yorkshire in 1895 the son of Albert Edward and Annie WIGGLESWORTH nee CONSERDINE who were married 19/09/1891 at St. Mary, Wakefield, Yorkshire. His father died in 1927. His mother died in 1927.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 2, Waterloo St. Tarnes Lane, Wakefield, Yorkshire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Railway Signal Box Worker.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Normanton as a Joint Clerk

He is recorded as Died on 15 June 1915 in Home aged 20
