Frederick Charles WILSHIRE was born at Woolwich, Kent in 1891 the son of Frederick and Alice WILSHIRE. His father died on .

In the 1891 census the family were living at 16, Mulgrave Place. Woolwich, Kent,. He was aged 1 Month He was a married man. His wife's name was Eliza Jennings WILSHIRE (nee PRIESTLY) They married at St. Paul, Mannigham, Yoorkshire on 6 September 1913

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company

Service History

He enlisted in the West Yorkshire Regiment at Bradford, Yorkshire. He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 19 May 1917 aged 26 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
