*Frederick Charles WILSHIRE was born at Woolwich, Kent in 1891 the son of Frederick and Alice WILSHIRE. His father died on .*

*In the 1891 census the family were living at 16, Mulgrave Place. Woolwich, Kent,. He was aged 1 Month He was a married man. His wife's name was Eliza Jennings WILSHIRE (nee PRIESTLY) They married at St. Paul, Mannigham, Yoorkshire on 6 September 1913*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the West Yorkshire Regiment at Bradford, Yorkshire.*

*He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 19 May 1917 aged 26*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal*
