Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company at Newton Heath as a

He was living at Moston. Manchester, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Royal Warwickshire Regiment at Middleton, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 21 October 1916 aged 21 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
