Personal History

Thomas WILSON was born at Salford, Lancashire in 1889 the son of Thomas Francis and Sarah Ellen WILSON nee VICKERS who were married 08/03/1879 at Christ Church, Salford, Lancashire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 7, Stanley Street, Moston, Manchester,. He was aged 21 with the occupation of Flannelette Raiser.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 14, Needhall Street, Salford, Lancashire,. He was aged 10

In the 1891 census the family were living at 9, West Stable Street, Salford, Lancashire,. He was aged

He was a married man. His wife's name was Elizabeth WILSON (nee CAYTON) They married at Prestwich Register Office or Registrar Attended on 22 March 1905. They had children: Robert b. 1909, Thomas Edward b. 1910

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Oldham Road as a Porter

He enlisted in the East Lancashire Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 9 August 1915 aged 26
