Personal History

Thomas WILSON was born at Longsight,, Manchester in 1895 the son of Thomas and Sarah WILSON. In the 1911 census the family were living at 9, Stamford Road, Longsight, Manchester, Lancs.,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Office Boy Sunlight Bros.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 704, Stockport Road, Longsight, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 6

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Newton Heath as a Cleaner

Service History

He was living at Manchester, Lancashire when he enlisted in the King's Own Scottish Borderers at the same place. and embarked for France on 17 February 1915. His last known address was Longsight, Manchester, Lancashire, Stamford Road, 9 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 31 July 1916 aged 21

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
